Visit Country Club Plaza, a 14-square block outdoor shopping and entertainment district, or River Market, situated snugly between Downtown and the south bank of the Missouri River, featuring historic brick buildings, loft apartments, bars and restaurants and the Midwest's largest farmers market—the City Market—which dates back to 1856.
